Resale brought in \$933 less CC processing fees.

Art to Remember fundraiser was completed. Funds to the PTO should be around 28% of the \$2,900 in sales ~ \$800. Late order window currently set to close on 4/29. Erica can call to ask them to close it earlier. Will get the totals for next week's meeting.

Lorrie asked if we can do cash/credit cards for our own membership table and they agreed. Discussed options for fundraiser vs. friendraiser. Decided that this year it may be better to give the options to reconnect and work on fundraisers for next year. Will include communication stating it is not a drop off event, all children must be accompanied by a responsible adult. Looking at maybe June 8 (has to be Mon or Wed or Sun).
